# Principal's report

\*Forensic Club for 6<sup>th</sup> grade is in place now through February, then another group will start. Activities include fingerprinting, Field Trips to Courthouse & CRPD Forensics Dept., and will finish up with a 3-week "crime" to solve

\*Magnet School kickoff meeting with Doreen Bush to review next steps. Current plan is for McKinley to be a STEAM Magnet school by 2019-2020 school year.

\*The Cedar Rapids Garden Club and Gazette were onsite today and, along with 50 6<sup>th</sup> graders, prepped the areas in the front of the building for the Prairie area where native wildflowers will be planted. Next spring a short fencing will be added. Look for the story in the Gazette soon.

#### **Classroom Learning Environment Discussion**

\*Parents voiced concerns about behaviors, rules, discipline within McKinley, asking for more information and guidance so they could communicate these things with their students.

\*Mrs. Wilson explained the "team" approach they are taking with 6<sup>th</sup> grade this year. Two teams of approximately 75 students each, follow a block schedule, fewer transitions, fewer teachers, more of a community environment.

\*Behavior assessments include all students, 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade and are placed in Tier 1, 2 or 3 depending on the outcome of the assessment. Tier 2 equates to some extra help like point sheets, assigning a mentor, check in/out policy, etc. Tier 3 includes outside resources to help students.

\*Major/minor office referral levels are set by District and are based on attendance, behavior and academics.

- \*Habitual behaviors can be input as a minor office referral so these are included in analysis
- \*Teams for Tier 1, 2 and 3 are in place and led by staff (teachers, support staff & administration). Tier 1 would like to have a parent member from each grade level. They meet the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month from 3:00-4:00. Call the office if you are interested or would like more information.
- \*Expectations are posted in hallways, classrooms, bathrooms and cafeteria
- \*Short-staffed right now due to long-term subs in place in Art and Science and two staff out on maternity leave. All staff working together to make sure classrooms are covered and students are learning.
- \*Emphasized emailing your student's teacher with concerns; they are happy to help

- \*Special Projects Update

  - \*Food Pantry-PTA donating \$100 for now; currently a \$600 balance; looking for private donations until corporate donations can be secured.
  - \*Marching Band-seeking funding for enrichment time (45 minutes between school dismissal on Fridays and Marching band start). Funds raised from Variety Show cannot be used for this so PTA will revisit possibly funding this at the December meeting.
- \*Discussion on student safety at drop off/pick up; Steve Funk called the City to inquire about possibly adding 80 feet of No Parking along McKinley Street, just before the school by the tennis courts; will update next month if he has heard back from the City Engineering Dept.
